

(Status of implementation as on 6.12.2017)

1. The Central Sector Scheme envisages the establishment of 62 FSWs in States/UTs across the country. Atleast one FSW is to be provided to each State/UT. The tender for establishment of FSWs has already been finalized and so far 21 FSWs have been sanctioned for 19 States/UTs of which 19 FSWs have been delivered to 17 States/UTs. Each FSW has a cost of Rs. 30 Lakh approximately (excluding GST)

2. The FSW is being provided to States/UTs on first-cum-first serve basis, depending upon their readiness. The State /UT's are required to provide the following details for having FSW from FSSAI:

(i) Location where FSW is to be sent by FSSAI.

(ii) (a) If run by the State, contact details of Nodal person in –charge of FSW.

(b) If run by other than the state/UT governments provide address and contact details of the organization/ association, contact person and person in-charge of FSW.

(iii) Account details for transfer of funds @ Rs 5 lakh/year for Petrol, Oil Lubricants (POL) and consumables.

(iv) Confirmation that dedicated manpower is available to operate MFTL, efficiently and effectively.

3. Proposals/information from the States/UTs were sought vide letters/ email dated 12.01.2017, 23.03.2017, 15.05.2017, 06.07.2017, 11.07.2017, 13.07.2017, 18.07.2017, 31.07.2017, 09.08.2017, 16.08.2017, 24.08.2017, 07.09.2017, 11.09.2017, 15.09.2017, 04.10.2017 and 10.10.2017, 25.10.2017, 30.10.2017 13.11.2017 and 23.11.17 The matter was also shared with the States/UTs representatives in the last two CAC meetings held on 16th May 2017, 22nd August, 2017 and 02nd November, 2017
