Central Government has issued several exemption notifications

whereby services provided by an individual as an advocate or as a

partnership frm of advocates by way of legal services are exempt

from the charge of service tax. That apart, there is a provision for

recovering service tax from the service recipient. Ignoring the above,

the impugned show cause cum demand notice has been issued

mechanically.
